Deacon's Corner

The memorial for St. Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, will be celebrated on Friday, July 15. St. Bonaventure is called "The Great Seraphic Doctor" of the Church who is known for his leadership of the Franciscan order and his contributions to theology and philosophy.

He was born in the Tuscany region of Italy in 1221. As a youth, it is believed that he was cured of a serious illness through the intercession of St. Francis of Assisi. He joined the Franciscan Order of Friars Minor in 1243. After his vows, he completed his studies in Paris and became good friends with St. Thomas Aquinas with whom he received his doctorate degree. Both of these saints were also friends with St. Louis, the King of France.

At the age of 35, St. Bonaventure became the General of his order and cultivated a spirit of unity through his leadership. He wrote "The Life of St. Francis," "The Soul's Journey into God," and assisted in the translation of the relics of St. Anthony of Padua. Pope Gregory X asked St. Bonaventure to prepare the Second Ecumenical Council of Lyons which sought to reestablish communion between the Latin and Greek Churches. St. Bonaventure did not see the council's completion as he died in 1274 while it was still in session.

May we ask St. Bonaventure to pray for us.
