## Deacon's Corner – The Importance of Prayer in Our Lives

In this Sunday's Gospel, as Jesus was praying, His disciples asked, "Lord, teach us to pray . . ." (Luke 11: 1) Christ answers their request by teaching them a prayer – the Our Father. Throughout Scripture, we see Jesus praying. This is an example for each of us to make time for prayer in our lives.

Prayer is "a vital and personal relationship with the living and true God" (CCC, 2558). It is a conversation with God recognizing His living presence in our lives. Through prayer, we strengthen our relationship with Our Lord by drawing closer to Him.

Prayer may take many forms. It may be formal prayers such as the Our Father or the Hail Mary; informal prayers such as a personal conversation with God; or a quiet reflection. The important aspect of prayer is making time by scheduling 10 or 15 minutes daily during natural breaks in one's life; i.e., in the morning, during lunch time, or in the evening. Select a quiet place to pray and try to pray in the same place which will help one to focus on this spiritual conversation with God.

Speak to Our Lord from your heart for Jesus tells us, "Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." (Luke 11: 9-10)
