## Deacon's Corner

We celebrate the feast day of Saint Camillus de Lellis, Priest on Monday, July 18. St. Camillus may be a saint who we are not familiar with, but his life is revealing. It shows us the wonders that Our Lord will work in our lives as we open our hearts and minds to Him.

Throughout his life, Camillus suffered with a leg ailment. Yet, he served in the Venetian army. He was a gambler and lost all his money at the age of 24 leaving him in poverty. He became employed at a Capuchin friary and was moved by a sermon which changed his life. He wanted to join the Capuchin order but was rejected twice because of the sore on his leg.

In 1584, he studied for the priesthood and was ordained at the age of 34. Camillus devoted his life to caring for the sick and found his own congregation, "The Order of Ministers of the Sick." This order served the sick in private homes, prisons, those suffering from the plague, and formed the first military field ambulance. He stressed cleanliness and technical skills in this ministry.

Canonized in 1742, St. Camillus, along with St. John of God, are the patron saints of hospitals, nurses and the sick. In times of personal and family illness, let us ask St. Camillus to pray for us.
