Deacon's Corner

Feast Day of St. Mary Magdalene

On Thursday, July 22, the Church celebrates the feast day of St. Mary Magdalene. St. Thomas Aquinas gave Mary Magdalene the title "Apostle of the Apostles." She was from Magdala, a small fishing town on the Sea of Galilee. Mary is present in some of the most important moments of Jesus' earthly ministry. St. Mary Magdalene is standing with Christ's mother and his mother's sister, Mary, the wife of Clopas at the foot of the Cross at Calvary and witnesses the crucifixion of Jesus. (John 19:25) She is with Joseph of Arimathea as he places Jesus' body in the sepulcher. Then, Mary Magdalene returns to the tomb on the first day of the week and discovers the tomb is empty. She tells Peter and John and they come to see the empty tomb. As Peter and John return home, Mary remains at the tomb crying. Suddenly she sees Jesus, but does not recognize him. She thinks He is the gardener and says to Him, "Sir, if you carried Him away, tell me where you laid Him, and I will take Him." (John 20:15) Jesus responds, "Mary." Immediately, she recognizes Jesus. Christ tells Mary, "Stop holding on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" St. Mary Magdalene is the patron saint of converts, women, repentant sinners, pharmacists, and many other causes. May we ask St. Mary Magdalene on her feast day to pray for us.
