

Deacon's Corner – Eternal Salvation

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead in the village of Bethany. This miracle is a sign of Christ's power over death. As a result of this sign, many people who had "seen what He had done, began to believe in Him" (John 11:45).

In these Scriptural passages, Jesus tells Martha and each of us, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." Then, Jesus asks her, "Do you believe this?" She said to Him, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world" (John 11:25-27).

Our Lord comes into our world to love and to save us "so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life" (John 3:16). Through His Passion, Death, and Glorious Resurrection, Jesus conquered sin and death. By loving God and our neighbors, Christ will bring us into eternal happiness.
