Deacon's Corner

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross will be celebrated on Tuesday, September 14. St. John's Gospel on this feast proclaims, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him." This feast day is the commemoration of Jesus' salvific death on the Cross and His Resurrection, which defeated death and opened to all who believe eternal salvation with Our Lord in Heaven.

The Cross of Jesus is a central sign of our Catholic faith. At the beginning of Mass on this feast day, The Entrance Antiphon emphasizes the importance of this feast. This prayer reads, "We should glory in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom is our salvation, life and resurrection, through whom we are saved and delivered." (Galatians 6:14)

With humility and thanksgiving on this feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, may we pray in the words of St. Francis of Assisi, "We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You, because by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world."
