## Deacon's Corner

We celebrate the feast of the Saints Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, the Archangels, on Wednesday, September 29. These archangels are three of the seven archangels who stand before the throne of God. They are the only angels named in Sacred Scripture. All three of these angels have important roles in salvation history.

St. Michael is the Prince of heavenly Host and the leader of all angels. Catholic tradition explains the roles of St. Michael are to escort the faithful to heaven at the hour of their death and to be champion of all Christians and the Church. He is the patron saint of police officers, doctors, military personnel and grocers.

St. Gabriel serves as a messenger for God. Gabriel appears to Daniel in the Old Testament to explain his visions. St. Gabriel is the patron saint of messengers, telecommunications workers and postal workers.

St. Raphael was described in the Book of Tobit when Tobit was healed of his blindness. St. Raphael is the patron saint of travelers, the blind, nurses, physicians and medical workers.

In his daily meditation; of this feast, Pope Francis explains the roles of these archangels, "Michael defends us, Gabriel gives us the Good News and Raphael takes us by the hand and walks with us; he helps us with many things that occur along the journey."
