Deacon's Corner

The Memorial for St. Monica will be celebrated on Tuesday, August 27. Monica was the mother of St. Augustine, Bishop and Doctor of the Church. She was born in northern Africa in 332 A.D. Monica was a devout Christian who was married to Patricius, a pagan who disliked Christianity.

Her husband refused to have their three children baptized. Despite his objections, Monica taught her children about Christianity and showed them how to live a Christian life. Her faith began to have an effect on her husband. After 16 years of praying and fasting for her husband's conversion, he was baptized.

St. Monica's two children, Navigus and Perpetua were baptized and entered religious life. However, Augustine embraced an earthly life. She did not give up on him. Rather, she continued to pray. After 14 years, Augustine converted to Jesus Christ and became a bishop and a renowned theologian and writer. Having achieved her maternal goal of bringing her family to God, she told her son St. Augustine, "Son, for mine own part I have no further delight in anything in this life. What I do here any longer, and to what end I am here, I know not, now that my hopes in this world are accomplished."

St. Monica is the patron saint of married women, victims of abuse, and mothers of wayward children. On this day, may we pray, "St. Monica, pray for our children that they may remain faithful to their baptismal vows. Give them strength to walk always in the ways of the Lord, despite the temptations of this world."
