### **Deacon's Corner**

The Memorial of Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus will be celebrated on Monday, July 29. Martha and Mary were sisters who lived with their brother Lazarus in the village of Bethany near Jerusalem. They were close friends of Jesus.

Our Savior often came to their home. The sisters also called on Jesus at the death of their brother, Lazarus.

Pope Francis established the memorial of Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus, replacing the previous memorial of Saint Martha on this date. In 2021, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Sacraments said, "In the household of Bethany, the Lord Jesus experienced the family spirit and friendship of Martha, Mary and Lazarus, and for this reason

the Gospel of John states that he loved them. Martha generously offered him hospitality, Mary listened attentively to his words and Lazarus promptly emerged from the tomb at the command of the one who humiliated death."

St. Martha is the patron saint of cooks and dieticians; St.

Mary the patron of lectors and spiritual studies; and St. Lazarus the patron of gravediggers. On this memorial, may we pray, "Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus, you befriended

Jesus as your Lord and God, and as the Son of Man, to whom you opened your home and lives. Please pray for me, that I will also open the home of my soul so as to befriend Him who is my God and is the Resurrection and the Life"
