This Sunday, December 29, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. On this feast day, we offer our families to God for His blessing and His protection. The Holy Family provides a beautiful example to inspire and encourage us in our daily life.

As the "domestic church," we look to the Holy Family as a model family in which both parents worked hard, helped each other, understood and accepted one another as God's gifts, and raised their Son in human and divine wisdom. The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds all parents that we have a responsibility to give good examples to our children as the Holy family did, by creating a home where love, tenderness, forgiveness, respect and service are the rule (CCC, 2223).
