Deacon's Corner

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Thursday, August 15. Our Church teaches that the Virgin Mary 'having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.' This doctrine was dogmatically defined by Pope Pius XII in November 1950. The feast of the Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation.

The Blessed Mother was the first of us to be taken into heaven. A tradition handed down from the early day of the Church says that Mary died in Jerusalem and was buried in a tomb. When the apostles opened the tomb again, her body was gone. God called her to heaven, body and soul, because she was the Mother of the Son of God. The beauty of Mary going to heaven shows us that we too are called to be with God, with Mary and the saints, in heaven forever. On this day, may we pray, 'Almighty ever-living God, who assumed the Immaculate Virgin Mary, the Mother of your Son, body and soul into heavenly glory, grant we pray, that, always attentive to the things that are above, we may merit to be sharers of her glory. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen
