Deacon's Corner - Lent

In his February 6th written message for Lent 2025, Pope Francis encourages each one of us "to journey together in hope" which is connected to the theme of the Church's 2025 Jubilee Year "Pilgrims of Hope." He encourages us to take the opportunity this Lenten Season to ask ourselves whether we are truly willing to listen to God's call to change our lives. The Holy Father writes, "This Lent, God is asking us to examine whether in our lives, in our families, in the places where we work and spend our time, we are capable of walking together with others, listening to them, resisting the temptation to become self-absorbed and to think only of our own needs." Pope Francis reminds us, "The Holy Spirit impels us not to remain self-absorbed, but to keep walking towards God and our brothers and sisters." In this spirit, there are many ways that we can walk together with Our Lord and our sisters and brothers this Lenten season and throughout our lives. One way is to read the Works of Mercy as Jesus describes them in Matthew 25:31-46. Then, put this teaching into practice and choose an act of service you can perform. Another practice is to pray for someone who is in need. Spend time volunteering in the parish or at a charitable organization. Visit and/or take a meal to a neighbor or person who is lonely or feels abandoned.

This week may we pray, "Lord, help me do your will."
