## **Deacon's Corner**

This week is the Fourth Week in Lent. This Sunday is traditionally known as Laetare Sunday, from the Latin word meaning "rejoice." As the people of God, we rejoice in anticipation of the Glorious Resurrection of Jesus Christ, Our Savior, on Easter Sunday, and His victory over sin and death. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells Nicodemus that the Son of Man will be raised up and those who believe in Him will have eternal life. This message is the Good News and the reason to rejoice in this season of Lent and in our lives.

Jesus, our Savior, loves us and is willing to sacrifice His life for us on the Holy Cross. In our Gospel, we hear of this overflowing love and supreme sacrifice of Christ, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life".

(John 3:14-21) This season of Lent is a beautiful time as we reflect about the love that Jesus has for us.
