#### **Deacon's Corner**

This week is the Fourth Week in Lent. This Sunday is traditionally known as Laetare Sunday, from the Latin word meaning "rejoice." As the people of God, we rejoice in anticipation of the Glorious Resurrection of Jesus Christ, Our Savior, on Easter Sunday, and His victory over sin and death. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells Nicodemus that the Son of Man will be raised up and those who believe in Him will have eternal life.
