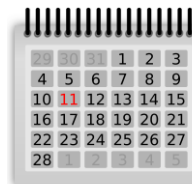

Deacon's Corner

This week, we will begin the season of Lent, one of the five liturgical seasons of the year, on Ash Wednesday, February 14. On this day, ashes will be placed on our foreheads to recall our own mortality and to begin our journey of penance. The 40 days of Lent will conclude at sundown on Holy Thursday.

During Lent, we can become Closer to Our Lord Jesus Christ through prayer, fasting and works of charity as we prepare for His Glorious Resurrection on Easter Sunday. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) explains that throughout Lent, "we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting.

Throughout this holy season, may we pray, "Heavenly Father transform us this Lent. Give us the strength and perseverance to commit ourselves to grow closer to you and to love you each day."
