Deacon's Corner

We begin the Third Week of Lent, which marks the approximate midpoint of the Lenten season. Our church encourages us to reflect about the meaning and significance of Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection for our lives.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus drives out the money changers from the Temple. He says, "Take these out of here and stop making my Father's house a marketplace" (John 2:13-25) In these words, God desires us to love and worship Him in our hearts. Lent is a time to invite Our Lord into the temple of our hearts. May we ask Jesus to come and purify our hearts.

In His love and mercy, He will turn the tables over in our hearts and help us to focus on the real meaning of life—to love God and to love our neighbors. Christ will help us to refocus and move away from the meaningless distractions and busyness in our life.

What are these life distractions that occupy our time?

Let us make time each day to pray and to quietly listen as God speaks to the temple of our hearts to transform us. Our Lord desires a deep and personal relationship with each one of us. This week, we might ask the Holy Spirit for an increase in trust in God's infinite mercy and grace; or to remember that all good comes from the Lord and to give him thanks for these blessings.
