Deacon's Corner

In this Sunday's Gospel, on the Twenty Seventh Week in Ordinary Time, the Apostles come to Jesus and say to Him, "Increase our faith" (Luke 17:5-10). Faith is the grace that opens the door to the heart of God and invites us to share in His divine life. This gift encourages each one of us to follow Him and to live in a close personal relationship with God.

With His help, our faith becomes the foundation on which we sustain our Christian lives to love God and to love one another. In our Holy Scripture, Jesus tells us that our faith gives us a mission in our daily lives. In the Gospel passage, the Apostles ask Hime to increase their faith. Yet, Jesus does not give them a direct answer. Rather, He tells them a parable about a servant who works in his master's fields and then comes home and serves the master his dinner.

Given this parable, Our Lord asks us to love as He loves and to serve as He serves. In this love and service that we give, we proclaim Jesus to others and testify to the faith that we have in God. In the second reading, St. Paul says, "Do not be ashamed of your testimony to our Lord but bear your share of hardship for the Gospel with the strength that comes from God." This week may we pray, "Lord, increase my faith. Teach me to trust in you and to serve you wherever you lead and in whatever you ask."
