Deacon's Corner

In the Gospel of St. John on the Sixth Sunday of Easter, Jesus tell His Apostles, "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you" (John 14:25-26) In the Gospel, Jesus promises that the Holy Spirit will guide each one of us into all truth as God reveals it.

The Holy Spirit comes to us in the sacrament of Baptism making us temples of God and disciples of Jesus. At Confirmation, we are strengthened by the Holy Spirit to bear witness to Jesus like the Apostles in the Gospel. In all the sacraments, the Holy Spirit acts based on our willingness and openness to let Him act, which is supported by a life of daily prayer.

Like the Apostles, the Holy Spirit illuminates the path of truth and helps us to discern God's will in our daily lives.

He strengthens our faith for us to live a life of love and service following in the footsteps of Jesus. The Holy Spirit also brings us spiritual gifts which enable us to serve and build up the body of Christ.
