Deacon's Corner

On this Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time in the Gospel of St. Luke, Jesus tells His disciples and us, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" (12:49-53) The fire that Jesus comes to bring in this world is the fire of His love and hope that we receive in our Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation and other Holy Sacraments.

In pursuing His mission of salvation in this world, Jesus brings division because some people will follow Him and others will not. In this Holy Scripture, Christ says, "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth?

No, I tell you, but rather division. From now on a household of five will be divided, three against two and two against three . . . " . As His disciples, we need to decide to follow Him or not and to share in His Baptism. This important spiritual choice among people results in this division within our families and in our communities. With the Holy Spirit's fire of love in our hearts, may we actively care, serve and bless one another with the gifts that we have received from Our Lord. Jesus wants this fire to inflame our hearts so we tell and show other people by our examples of His love and mercy. During this week, may we pray, "Come, Holy Spirit! Set my heart on fire."
