Deacon's Corner

On Monday, September 23, we will celebrate the Memorial of St. Pius of Pietrelcina, Priest, also known as Padre Pio. He was born in 1887 in the small farming village of Pietrelcina in southern Italy. He joined the Capuchin Friars at the age of sixteen and was ordained a priest seven years later.

On September 20, 1918, as he was offering his thanksgiving after Mass, Padre Pio had a vision of Jesus Christ. When the vision ended, he had in his hands, feet and side stigmata (the sacred marks of the crucified Jesus). Padre Pio rarely left the friary, but many people came to the friary and participated in the 5 AM mass that he celebrated every morning. Then, he would hear confessions throughout the day and bless the sick who would visit the church. Throughout his ministry, he would often say, "I only want to be a poor friar who prays."

In 1956, he established the House for the Relief of Suffering, a hospital that serves 60,000 people a year. Today, there are also over 400,000 members worldwide in prayer groups initiated by Padre Pio. St. Pius passed on to eternal life on September 23, 1968. Pope John Paul II canonized Padre Pio of Pietrelcina in 2002.

St. Pius is the patron saint of adolescents and civil defense volunteers and invoked in cases of stress relief and spiritual healing. On this day, may we pray, "Loving Father, touch me now with your healing hands, for I believe that your will is for me to be well in mind, body, soul and spirit."
