Deacon's Corner

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, also known as All Souls Day, is celebrated this Sunday, November 2. The sacred liturgy on this day commemorates the beautiful tradition of celebrating the mass for our beloved dead. We ask God to grant them salvation and to let His perpetual light of eternal life shine upon them. In today's Gospel, Jesus promised each one of us, "for this is the will of my Father, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have eternal life, and I shall raise him on the last day" (John 6:37-40).

In this divine promise, everyone who lives and dies in Christ will be raised up on the last day. It creates a special link between all of us who are baptized into Christ—it makes us members of one family. In this body of Christ, we depend upon one another because we are members of this mystical union. This means that our prayers for each other—both for the living and the dead—are more than good thoughts. Our prayers are powerful means to connect with Our Lord and His love and mercy for the intentions that we express for our departed loved ones.

On this day, may we pray for our departed family members and friends, "Father, thank you for the people you have placed in our lives, especially those who now sleep in faith. Together, we place our hope in your promise of the Resurrection."
