Deacon's Corner

The Memorial for St. Anthony of Padua, Priest and Doctor of the Church, will be celebrated on Thursday, June 13. St. Anthony lived during the 13th century and possessed a great zeal for the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. One day, Saint Anthony learned about a man in the town of Rimini named Bononillo who did not share this same belief.

St. Anthony challenged the merchant, "If the mule you ride adores the Body of Christ in the Eucharist, would you believe in the truth of the Blessed Sacrament?" Bononillo agreed. He decided he would starve his mule for three days and bring it to the town square.

St. Anthony would bring the Blessed Sacrament to the square. Then, the mule would be placed in front of the hay. St. Anthony would stand a few yards away with the Blessed Sacrament.

To prepare, St. Anthony fasted for three days. On the day of the test, Bononillo brought his mule and placed the hay in front of the mule. St. Anthony came with the Holy Eucharist. The mule turned his head and walked over to Saint Anthony. The animal bent his front legs and kneeled in adoration. When Bononillo saw this miraculous event, he immediately knelt down and professed his belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The Eucharistic presence of Jesus is a gift that Jesus gave to each of us, one that requires faith, and for that reason alone cannot be explained.
