Deacon's Corner

On this Sunday, we celebrate the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. This feast day celebrates the anniversary of the dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran, which is the cathedral church of the Pope and the "mother church" of all Catholic churches. Today's scriptural readings celebrate the dedication of this Basilica and focus on a deeper spiritual reality.

In the gospel according to St. John, Jesus cleanses the Temple in Jerusalem. Then, He proclaims, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." The Gospel explains, "He was speaking about the temple of his Body. Therefore, when He was raised from the dead, His disciple remembered that He had said this . . ."

These passages emphasize that Jesus Christ, Our Savior, is the true sanctuary and dwelling place of God. In our second reading, St. Paul tells us, "Brothers and sisters: You are God's building. Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?" Each one of us are the living stones of His Church. Jesus loves, heals, and renews us in our faith as his disciples. We are renewed by the Holy Eucharist, the holy sacraments, His living words in Scripture and by serving our sisters and brothers. On this feast, may we pray, "Heavenly Father, you dwell in the hearts of your faithful. Renew your Church and make each of us a living stone in the temple of Christ's body."
