Deacon's Corner

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity this Sunday, June 15. As Catholics, we believe that the one true God is the living God in three Divine Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells his Apostles and us, "When he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason, I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you (John 16 12-15)."

St. Pope John Paul II explained the Holy Trinity in this way, "Our God, in his deepest mystery, is not a solitude but a family, since he has in himself fatherhood, sonship, and the essence of the family, which is love." St. John the Apostle always emphasized that "God is love." It is the love of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit that created each one of us.

God, who created us in His image, wants us to share His love with one another. As children of God we practice this love by bringing people together and showing them that we are all sisters and brothers with God who loves them. On this Solemnity, may we pray, "The Father is my hope. The Son is my refuge. The Holy Spirit is my protector. Glory to the holy and undivided Trinity, now and forever. Amen."
