Deacon's Corner

The day after Christmas, Tuesday, December 26, is the feast of St. Stephen, the first martyr of the Church. Stephen was one of the first among the seven men chosen as deacons to assist the Apostles in their mission. He was a person "filled with faith and the Holy Spirit" who performed great works among the people. The elders and the scribes stirred the people against St. Stephen during his ministry of service. They said he blasphemed Moses and God. (Acts of Apostle 6:1-15)

Arrested and brought before the Sanhedrin, St. Stephen gave a speech, the longest recorded in the Acts of the Apostles. He stated that God had prepared the world for the coming of His Son. But, the leaders of the people had resisted the Holy Spirit. He concluded with the words, "Behold, I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

Angered by these words, he was taken outside the city of Jerusalem near the Gate of Damascus and stoned to death. During his last moments of life, in imitation of Jesus, St. Stephen prayed that God would receive his spirit and forgive those who had committed this act (Acts of Apostles 7:1-60). St. Stephen is the patron saint of deacons and altar servers. May we pray, "St. Stephen, pray that I may always be eager to serve God and His Church and that I may never hesitate to answer God's call in my life."
