Deacon's Corner

This Lenten season invites us into a deeper and personal relationship with Jesus, Our Savior. It is a time when we remember and thank Christ for His great love as he sacrificed His precious life on the Cross for the forgiveness of our sins. He destroyed death by His Glorious Resurrection on Easter.

During Lent, to deepen our love for God, we are asked to focus on almsgiving. Almsgiving is performing works of charity and service for our sisters and brothers. In this second week of Lent, our Gospels at the daily masses provide important spiritual guidance about almsgiving to show our love for Jesus and all people who

need our support.

In Monday's Gospel, Jesus says, "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. . .Give and gifts will be given to you" (Luke 6:36-38). In the Gospel of St. Matthew on Tuesday, Our Lord emphasizes to the crowds "that the greatest among you must be your servant" (Matthew 23:11). Christ again encourages each of us in Wednesday's Gospel, whoever wishes to be great among you shall be your servant" (Matthew 20:26).

Jesus Himself came into the world "not to be served, but to serve and to give His life for ransom for many" (Matthew 20:28). Like Our Savior, He asks each of us to serve others in charity and kindness through our words and actions as we see His presence in the poor, the sick, the imprisoned and others in need.
