Deacon's Corner

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist "A man named John was sent from God. He came for testimony to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him" (John 1-7). The Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist will be celebrated on Saturday, June 24. St. John began his ministry at the age of 27, in the desert, living on locusts and honey while dressing in a tunic made of camel hair. He was a prophet and forerunner who came to announce the coming of Jesus Christ, the Messiah and to encourage people to reform their lives. John called people to repentance along the banks of the Jordan River, baptizing them in its waters. Jesus Himself approached John to be baptized. John proclaimed, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1-29). Initially, John resisted baptizing Jesus; but out of obedience agreed when Jusus explained that He wanted to set an example of righteous behavior. Like St. John, as Christ's disciples, may we share the Good News with all that we meet in our daily lives. On this solemnity, may we pray, "Grant, we pray, almighty God, that your family may walk in the way of salvation and, attentive to what Saint John the Precursor urged, may come safely to the One he foretold, our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.
