Deacon's Lorner

The Lenten season will begin on Ash Wednesday, February 22. The forty days of Lent are a time when we pray, fast and perform works of mercy as a way to prepare ourselves for Christ's death and His resurrection at Easter. During Lent, "we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully" (U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops Bishops website). The Gospel of St. Matthew on this day proclaims, "Take care not to perform righteous deeds in order that people may see them; otherwise, you will have no recompense from your heavenly Father." (6:1) The reception of ashes is a reminder that the purpose of Lent is not to perform public demonstrations of piety and penance but to seek a personal conversion of one's heart through Our Lord. Our Lenten journey is a time we seek Christ, ask for His help, and learn love like Jesus, Our Savior.
