Deacon's Corner


Holy Week

This week, we gather together to pray and remember the Passion of Our Lord. The Passion of Christ, from the Latin word "patior" means "suffer." It refers to the sufferings Our Lord endured for our redemption from the Agony in the Garden until His death on Calvary.

After the Last Supper, Jesus goes to the Garden of Gethsemane with His disciples. He prays, "Father, if it is your will, take this cup from me; yet not my will but yours be done" (Luke 22:42). Then, Jesus is arrested and tried by the Sanhedrin. He is condemned to death for blasphemy. The leaders take Jesus to Pontius Pilate, the Roman Governor, who could order the execution. After scourging Him, Pilate fearing a revolt hands Christ over to be crucified.

We must remember what our Lord endured for our salvation. He offers Himself as the perfect sacrifice for sin on the cross and washes away our offenses with His blood. The prophet Isaiah wrote 700 years before Jesus' crucifixion, "He was pierced for our offenses, crushed for our sins. He bore the punishment that makes us whole, by his stripes we were healed... the Lord laid upon him the guilt of us all" (Isaiah 53:5-6). God loves each of us that He mercifully chooses to rescue us from sin and death.

During this week, may we pray, "Dearest Lord, we remember the supreme sacrifice you made for us on the cross so that we might have eternal life. Help us conquer the sins and temptations we encounter as we enter into the new life you offer us."
