Deacon's Corner

The Feast of Saint Luke, evangelist

The Feast of Saint Luke, evangelist, will be observed on Friday, October 18. St. Luke is one of the four evangelists who were authors of the Gospels. The early Church Fathers accepted that St. Luke authored the Gospel of St. Luke and the Acts of the Apostles.

Throughout St. Luke's Gospel, Jesus accepts the sinner who wishes to return to God's mercy. Our Savior loves the poor, wants the door to God's kingdom open to all, and proclaims God's mercy for all people. In this Gospel, the six miracles and eighteen parables of Jesus are described that are not found in the other gospels. This Holy Scripture also tells the story of Lazarus and the Rich Man who ignored him (Luke 16: 19-31). We hear the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10: 29-37) and the story of the one grateful leper who is a Samaritan (Luke 17:11-19). In Luke's gospel, Mary's Magnificat is contained where she proclaims that God "has brought down the powerful from their thrones and lifted up the lowly; he has filled the hungry with good things and sent the rich away empty" (Luke 1:52-53).

St. Luke traveled with St. Paul and evangelized Greece and Rome with him. When Paul is imprisoned and put to death in Rome, it is Luke that stays with him to the end. St. Luke is the patron saint of artists, doctors, surgeons, and bachelors. On his feast day, may we read and pray about a passage in this Gospel and ask God to help us understand its meaning for our lives.
