### **DEACON'S CORNER**

#### The Solemnity of the Saints

The Solemnity of the Saints or "All Saints Day" will be celebrated on Wednesday. November 1. a holy day of obligation. In 609 A.D., All Saints Day was instituted by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Pantheon at Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the Martyrs.

The preface for the Mass on this day explains this feast, "Around your throne the saints, our brothers and sisters, sing your praise forever. Their glory fills us with joy, and their communion with us in your church gives us inspiration and strength as we hasten on our pilgrimage of faith." These saints are our brothers and sisters, who are in communion with us and who are able to strengthen us by their intercessions and prayers, since we are on the same spiritual journey which they have completed.

On this day, we venerate the holy women and men who have been canonized by the Holy Church. Saints are "persons who, after having lived a life of virtue, die in the state of grace and have been granted the reward of eternal life by God. The saints enjoy the beatific vision and unceasingly interceded for us still in earthly life." They serve as our models and inspiration for our spiritual growth in daily life (U.S. Catholic Catechism for Adults).

On this holy day, may we pray, "O Lord, give us the protection of the saints. Grant us their assistance in overcoming temptation and gaining the fullness of life with You. Amen."

Mother Cabrini Parish announces it's Thanksgiving Gift Card Raffle


