Deacon's Corner

Lent

As Jesus' disciples, we begin Lent on Ash Wednesday, March 5. Lent is a solemn season as we prepare for the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection on Easter Sunday. This solemn season of preparation is 40 days of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving where we remember Jesus' 40 days that He spent in the desert fasting after His baptism by John the Baptist. Lent will end at sundown on Holy Thursday, April 17. The Mass on Holy Thursday will begin the special period of time known as the Sacred Triduum.

Lent is a time of simplicity, prayer, sacrifice, and a time of strengthening our relationship with Jesus. Each of the Lenten practices offers us an opportunity to come closer to Christ. Daily prayer is a conversation and a living friendship with Our Lord. Fasting denies worldly goods and unites us with the sacrifice of Our Savior. Almsgiving or our charity shows the love that we have for our sisters and brothers in need through our gifts of time and treasure. An important question this Lent for us is: How will we approach these days and gain the graces they offer us?

During this Lenten season, let us invite Jesus into our hearts and ask Him to bring His overflowing love, healing, and mercy into our lives. Every day during Lent, may we offer a simple prayer that is said during the Stations of the Cross, "We adore You O Christ and we bless you because by your Holy Cross You have redeemed the World."
