Pentecost Sunday

On Sunday, June 8, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. As a Church community, we commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the birth of the Church, 50 days after Easter. The Apostles receive the gift of the Holy Spirit which enables them to preach the Gospel. In the first reading on Pentecost Sunday, the Acts of the Apostles explains, "When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim (2: 1-11)." The Apostles were empowered to proclaim the "mighty acts of God" in the languages of "every nation under heaven."

Pentecost Sunday reminds us of the gift of the Holy Spirit and the importance of the Spirit of God in our lives. The Holy Spirit enables each one of us to live and practice a life transformed by God's love and power. Through the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit to go out into our communities to proclaim the Good News through our words and actions. As Jesus' disciples, we are to proclaim God's mighty love to all. This is our mission.

On this day, may we pray, "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth."
