WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

In observance of the "World Day of the Sick", the sacrament of anointing of the sick will be offered to those seeking healing and comfort. It will be hosted by St. Joseph Church, Danville on Sunday, February 11th, 2024 beginning at 11:45 AM following the 10:30 Mass that morning. Everyone is welcome. Following the anointings, the Harrisburg Guild of the Catholic Medical Association invites all to remain for a Holy Hour of Prayer for the sick and those who care for them. It will begin around noon. Physicians, Nurses and medical professionals are particularly encouraged to attend to pray for the patients for which they care. The Holy Hour will include Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Scripture readings, prayers and a homily reflection by Fr. Timothy Marcoe, pastor of St. Joseph Church followed by Benediction. The World Day of the Sick is observed each year on February 11th which is the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes. The day was instituted over 30 years ago by Saint Pope John Paul II and is a day of awareness intended for "prayer and sharing of offering one's suffering for the good of the Church and of reminding everyone to see in his sick brother or sister the face of Christ"... DEACON'S CORNER

St. Agatha, Virgin and Martyr

On Monday, February 5, we celebrate the Memorial of St. Agatha, Virgin and Martyr. She is also known as "Agatha of Sicily" and is one of the most venerated virgin martyrs of the Catholic Church. St. Agatha was born in a noble family in 231 and from childhood dedicated her life to God.

Quintianus, a high-ranking diplomatic Roman official, wanted to force her to turn away from her religion and her vow of celibacy by forcing her to marry him. She refused. He had her imprisoned and continuously tortured to change her mind. During these trials, St. Agatha had a vision of the Apostle, St. Peter, who comforted her and healed her wounds through his prayers.


After this miraculous curing of her wounds, Quintianus mercilessly tortured her over and over. When she was returned to prison dying, Agatha prayed, "Lord, my Creator, you have ever protected me from the cradle; you have taken me from the love of the world, and given me patience to suffer: receive now my soul."

St. Agatha is the patron saint of Sicily, breast cancer patients, and rape victims. She is considered to be a powerful intercessor when people suffer from fires. On her feast day, may we pray, "Saint Agatha, you suffered assault and indignity because of your faith and purity. Help to heal all those who are survivors of assault and protect those women who are in danger. Amen"
