## Deacon's Corner St. Martin de Tours, Bishop

On Monday, November 11, the Memorial of St. Martin of Tours, Bishop will be celebrated at daily mass. St. Martin was born in 316 A.D. in present day Hungary and raised in Italy. He began to study about Christianity at an early age. As a young man, he served in the Roman army as a cavalryman. Yet, he desired a higher purpose in his life.

Legend explains that when Martin served in France, he discovered a shivering beggar clutching his rags around him on a cold day. He noticed no one was helping the man. Martin had nothing with him but the soldier's clothes he wore. He removed his wool cavalry cloak, cut it in two, and gave half to the beggar. Later, Martin had a vision in which Jesus was wearing the cloak he had given the beggar. Jesus told angels around him that it had been given to him by Martin. St. Martin immediately became baptized and refused to fight the invading France on the basis of his conscience.

As a Christian missionary, he began to preach the Gospel throughout the region and serve the poor and the sick. This humble man of God was chosen by the people of Tours as their bishop. He reluctantly accepted. As bishop, he established over 3,500 churches and founded the Benedictine abbey at Liguge, the oldest known abbey in Europe.
