Catholics can receive a plenary indulgence by praying before a Nativity scene



This year, Catholics will be able to receive a plenary indulgence from Dec. 8, the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin

Mary, to Feb. 2, 2024, the feast of the Presentation in the Temple of Our Lord Jesus Christ, by praying before a Nativity scene in a Franciscan church.

Earlier this year, on the feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the faithful gathered at the Basilica of St. Francis in Assisi, Italy, to honor the beloved Italian saint and celebrate the 800th anniversary of the approval of the Rule of St. Francis (1223) and the creation of the Nativity scene in Greccio.

As part of the celebration of this Franciscan Centenary, the Conference of the Franciscan Family asked Pope Francis for the approval of this plenary indulgence by visiting the churches run by Franciscan families throughout the world and stopping in prayer in front of the Nativity scenes set up there."

The Apostolic Penitentiary welcomed the request, allowing the faithful to receive this indulgence under the usual conditions.

DEACON'S CORNER

St. Francis de Sales, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

The Memorial of St. Francis de Sales, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, will be celebrated on Wednesday, January 24. St. Francis was born into a noble family near the city of Geneva, Switzerland in 1567. Since childhood, he knew that he wanted to serve God by becoming a priest, but kept it silent from his family. His father wanted him to enter a career in law and politics.

St. Francis attended the University of Paris and then received a doctorate of law from the University of Padua. He continued to study theology and never lost the desire to become a priest. One day, as he was riding his horse, he fell three times from the horse. Each time, the sword from his scabbard fell out and formed the shape of a cross. After discussions with his father, he was ordained a priest and eventually became the bishop of Geneva. During this time, through his personal visits to homes and villages, Francis brought back 40,000 Calvinists to the Catholic Church. St. Francis wrote the book, "Introduction to the Devout Life" which he greated for the laity. He

He said, "By turning your eyes on God, your whole soul will be filled with God." The test of prayers was a person's actions. "To be an angel in prayer and a beast in one's relations with people is to go lame on both legs."

May we imitate St. Francis' gentle nature and his daily desire to serve God and His people.


