Deacon's Corner

St. Peter Damian, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

The feast day of St. Peter Damian, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, will be celebrated on Friday, February 21. He was orphaned as a young boy. One of his brothers took Peter in and provided him with an excellent education. After teaching at a university, at the age of 28, he entered Benedictine monastic life at Fonte-Avellana. St. Peter Damian was appointed Prior of the house, a position he would hold for the remainder of his life. Under his direction, the monastery expanded and the library which the great works of the Church were carefully collected and catalogued. Later, he established many other monasteries.

Seven popes in succession made him their constant advisor. Pope Stephen IX appointed Peter the cardinal-bishop of Ostia. Peter was a reformer and worked hard to confront simony which is the buying of church offices and encouraged the priests to observe celibacy. He urged diocesan clergy to live together and to maintain scheduled prayer and religious observances. His writings remain instrumental in clarifying Church doctrine on issues such as Purgatory, the Eucharist, the Sacraments, and Christian virtues. Throughout his life, Peter was charitable to the poor. Often, he would have the poor at his dinner table and would personally minister to their spiritual needs.
