DEACON'S CORNER St. Ignatius of Loyola

The Memorial of St. Ignatius of Loyola, Priest will be celebrated on Monday, July 31. Born in 1491 in northern Spain, as a young man, St. Ignatius became a soldier in the Spanish army. He was wounded in a battle with the French. As Ignatius was recovering, he experienced a conversion by reading about the lives of Jesus Christ and the saints.

Through this spiritual transformation, St. Ignatius became involved in spiritual direction. Living outside of the town of Manresa, he began to write his prayers and insights in his book. Spiritual Exercises, which has become an influential book for individual discernment and retreats. Called to the priesthood, he completed his studies at the University of Paris and was ordained. Then, with a group of friends, who included St. Francis Xavier and St. Peter Faber, St. Ignatius founded the Society of Jesus, or the Jesuits.

For the next 15 years, St. Ignatius led the Jesuit order. Jesuits have established churches, schools, and universities throughout the world. St. Ignatius is the patron saint of retreats, education, and soldiers.

On this Memorial, may we pray St. Ignatius' Suscipe Praver, "Take Lord, and receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will, all that I have and possess. Thou hast given all to me. To Thee, O Lord, I return it. All is Thine, dispose of it wholly according to Thy will. Give me Thy love and Thy grace, for this is sufficient for me."
