The members of Our Lady of Hope Parish family will have the opportunity next weekend to "spiritually" adopt a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all

conceived babies are allowed to be born. It is these babies you are being asked to "adopt". The ninemonth program will begin on Sunday, May 8, 2022 and end on February 8, 2023.

You may "adopt" a child individually or as a family by signing up during the weekend of May 1st by going on to the HDCCW website at <u>hdccw.webs.com.</u> You will be asked to name the child for whom you will be praying and to pray for your unborn child and all unborn children. Each month for nine months, participants will receive reports from the Legislation/ Respect Life Commission of the HDCCW on the development of the adopted baby in the womb.



DEACON'S CORNER

Since the 13th century, the month of May in our Holy Church has been dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God. Pope Francis explains, "She is that woman who rejoiced in the presence of God, who treasured everything in her heart, and who let herself be pierced by the sword. Mary is the saint among the saints, blessed above all others. She teaches us the way of holiness and she walks ever at our side. She does not let us remain fallen and at times she takes us into her arms without judging us." (*Gaudete et Exsultate*, no. 176)

The month of May is a beautiful time of the year to honor our Heavenly Mother and to seek her intercession as the Mother of God and the Mother of the Holy Church. It is common to celebrate this Marian month through such practices as the May crowning, praying the rosary daily in community before or after mass, praying the litanies of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and through personal prayers.

May we pray, "May my heart burn with the love of thy Divine Son, and of thee, His blessed Mother, not for a month alone, but for time and eternity; may I thirst for the promotion of His honor and thine. Receive me, O Mary, the refuge of sinners! Grant me a Mother's blessing and a Mother's care, now and at the hour of my death. "Amen."

The price of cooking oil has been increasing and we only use Crisco Oil to make our delicious potato cakes. We greatly appreciate your help.


