

Deacon's Corner Lent

The Lenten season will begin on Ash Wednesday, February 22. The forty days of Lent are a time when we pray, fast, and perform works of mercy as a way to prepare ourselves for Christ's death and His resurrection at Easter.

During Lent, "we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully" (*U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops website*).

The Gospel of St. Matthew on this day proclaims, "Take care not to perform righteous deeds in order that people may see them; otherwise, you will have no recompense from your heavenly Father." (6:1) The reception of ashes is a reminder that the purpose of Lent is not to perform public demonstrations of piety and penance but to seek a personal conversion of one's heart through Our Lord. Our Lenten journey is a time as we seek Christ, ask for His help, and learn to love like Jesus, Our Savior.


