The first candle lit is a purple candle that symbolizes hope and is called the "Prophet's Candle." The prophets of the Old Testament, especially Isaiah, waited in hope for the Messiah's arrival. The purple color symbolizes royalty, repentance, and fasting.

The Geisinger Shamokin Area Community Hospital provides medical services to many of our parishioners and family members. If a patient at Geisinger-Shamokin Hospital is in need of an anointing or is in danger of death, a family member is encouraged to talk with a hospital staff member, the hospital chaplain, and/or our parish office staff member so a priest can visit the patient and minister to their needs. There has been an established process at this specific hospital and the priests of the Franciscan community at Mother Cabrini, Our Lady of Hope, and St. Patrick's parishes will respond to the patient and/or family member's request once they are contacted by the hospital or the parish staff member. It is also important to note since March 2022, there is a Catholic hospital visitation ministry that has been implemented at Geisinger Shamokin campus. One of our deacons and two Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion pray and distribute Holy Communion to Catholic patients and/or visiting family members. One of our parishioners is a member of this team! They visit the patients four days during the week to meet the patient's spiritual needs. We also have a full-time chaplain at the Geisinger in Danville.

#### **Deacon's Corner**

#### **First Week of Advent**

The word Advent comes from Latin which means "coming." It is a time to prepare for the coming of our Messiah, Jesus Christ at Christmas. Our Newborn Savior also comes into our daily lives in His Holy Church, the Holy Eucharist and the Sacraments, the Word of God, and in our neighbors who are in need of charity and kindness.

This Advent season also reminds us of the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of time. In the Gospel of St. Matthew on this First Sunday of Advent, Jesus proclaims, "For you do not know on which day your Lord will come. . . So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."

With less than four weeks until Christmas, Advent is a time to renew and enliven our relationship with Jesus. Pope Francis explains, "Advent is a time to stop and ask ourselves how to prepare for Christmas and what we should do for Jesus and others. It may be visiting someone who is alone, helping the elderly or the ill, or serving the poor. It may also mean asking for forgiveness for our mistakes, clarifying a misunderstanding, praying more, or guietly reflecting on a passage of Holy Scripture."

May we take this time to welcome Christ into our hearts in new and deeper ways.
