


A Parent Session will be held on March 20, 2022 at 9:45 AM in Our Lady of Hope Church

#### **DEACON'S CORNER**

We will celebrate the feast of St. Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland and our sister parish in Trevorton, on Thursday, March 17. St. Patrick arrived in Slane in 433 A.D. as the Bishop of Ireland. For 40 years, he preached the Good News of Christ and converted many people to the faith in Ireland. In his ministry, he ordained many priests, created dioceses, and built monasteries and schools. On his feast day, let us pray the prayer that St. Patrick wrote, "Christ with me, Christ before me, Christ behind me, Christ within me, Christ beneath me, Christ above me, Christ at my right, Christ at my left."

Two days later, on Saturday, March 19, we celebrate the solemnity of St. Joseph, the spouse of the Blessed Mother and the foster father of Our Lord. St. Joseph had descended from the royal lineage of David. Holy Scripture shows us that he was a humble, upright, and compassionate man who was always open to God's will as he cared for Mary and Jesus. St. Joseph is the patron saint of the Universal Church, fathers, working people, and a happy death. May we pray on this day, "Saint Joseph, patron of the universal Church, watch over the Church as you watched over Jesus, help protect it, and guide it. Amen."
