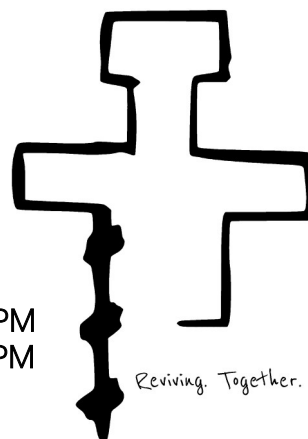

DEACON'S CORNER

The first week in Ordinary Time begins on Monday, January 10. In the Gospel for this day, after Jesus' Baptism, He passes by the Sea of Galilee and sees Simon and his brother, Andrew casting nets into the sea. Jesus says to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." They left their nets and followed Him. Then, Jesus sees James and his brother, John and they too follow Him leaving their father, Zebedee. (Mark 1:14-20)

Jesus comes into our world to proclaim the Good News of God's eternal plan of love and salvation for all. As with His first disciples, Christ comes to each of us and calls us to share in His earthly ministry - to love Our Lord and our neighbors.
