

Topic: "This is the Way"

#### DEACON'S CORNER

During this first week of Lent, on Monday, March 7, we celebrate the optional memorial of Saints Perpetua and Felicity, Martyrs. At mass, as the celebrant prays Eucharistic Prayer I, he will invoke the names of these two martyrs, as well as other saints, prior to the congregation praying the Our Father.

Saint Perpetua was a well-educated, 22-year-old noblewoman from Carthage in North Africa. She was a mother of an infant son and was devoted to her Christian faith. Perpetua was arrested during the reign of the Roman Emperor Severus because she would not renounce her faith in Christ. Felicity, a slave and expectant mother, was also arrested and convicted with other devout believers. From their prison, they were sent to the public games in the amphitheater in Carthage. There, they stood side by side and were martyred in 203 A.D. Felicity gave birth to a healthy daughter just days before her death in the arena. Her baby was raised by a Christian woman in Carthage.

St. Perpetua wrote a diary about the conditions that led to their deaths. Years later, this diary was published as "The Passion of Saints Perpetua and Felicity." It is one of the earliest writings by a Christian mother.

Saints Perpetua and Felicity are the patron saints of mothers, expectant mothers, and widows. On their feast day, may we ask these two holy women, "To pray for us that our faith will never waver despite the trials and pain in our lives."
