DEACON'S CORNER

The Memorial for St. Catherine of Siena, Virgin and Doctor of the Church, will be celebrated on Friday, April 29. St. Catherine, born in 1347 in Siena, Italy, did not enter the convent but joined the Third Order of St. Dominic at the age of 18. Throughout her life, St. Catherine served the poor and gave food and clothing to people in need.

St. Catherine had a spiritual vision which encouraged her to continue her ministry to help the poor and those who were sick. She began to visit and care for people in hospitals and homes. Her ministry attracted other followers who joined her in helping to serve the poor and sick.

In 1377, she established a monastery for women outside of Siena. St. Catherine was a prolific writer composing "The Dialogue," a conversation between God and herself; 400 letters for spiritual instruction; and prayers. Along with St. Teresa of Avila, Pope Paul VI declared her a Doctor of the Church as a result of these spiritual and theological works. She was also instrumental in having Pope Gregory XI return to Rome from Avignon, France restoring the Papacy to Rome.

The final words of St. Catherine of Siena were the same as Our Lord's, "Father, into Your hands I commend my spirit." Saint Catherine is the patroness of nurses, fire prevention, illness, and miscarriages. St. Catherine of Siena pray for us.
