The Ascension of the Lord

The Ascension of the Lord, a day of great joy, will be celebrated on Thursday, May 18. On this day, Jesus Christ ascends into heaven and takes His seat at the right hand of God the Father. The Ascension takes place 40 days after the Resurrection of our Savior. During the 40 days after Easter Sunday, Christ was teaching the Apostles and discussing the Kingdom of God with His disciples.

With His Ascension into heaven, He came to show us the way to God's heavenly kingdom. Our Lord wants all of us to be with Him in heaven and to live in eternal happiness. Today is also a day that we need to think about and act upon the mission of our lives. In today's first reading and Gospel, Jesus speaks His last words while on earth. He says to His disciples and us, "You will be my witnesses . . . to the ends of the earth" (Acts of Apostles, 1:8).
