The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15th is <u>**not**</u> a Holy Day of Obligation this year.


Religious Education & Sacrament Preparation

Registration for the Religious Education and Sacrament Programs was held on Sunday, August 7, 2022. If you were not able to attend the registration, please stop at Our Lady of Hope Parish Office Monday or Tuesday from 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM or Wednesday from 9:00 AM -12:00 PM to register. The fee for registration is \$30.00/child.

First Penance/Communion and Confirmation Candidates can also register at the above times.

Any child that will be in 2nd grade and has completed 1 year of Religious Education or attended 1st grade at Lourdes, will be eligible to register. Confirmation candidates in 6th grade, and also 7th or 8th grade students that were not registered last year are required to register. Students must complete 3 years of Confirmation Preparation in order to receive the Sacrament. There is a registration fee of \$30.00 for new registrations to cover books, supplies, etc.

To have our books delivered in time for class, registration is due by August 24, 2002.

The Solemnity of The Assumption of Blessed Virgin Mary

As a faith community, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Monday, August 15. In the glorious mystery of the Assumption, "The Immaculate Virgin when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of death." This dogma of the Assumption was declared in 1950 by Pope Pius XII. (*Catechism of Catholic Church*, 966)

As believers, this solemnity is a day of great joy. On this day, in the Gospel of St. Luke, "Mary said, My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." This is how we should live. The Assumption is a living sign of God's love and tender care for us. Like the Blessed Mother, we need to proclaim the greatness of the Lord and to share Jesus' love with others who are in need of His compassion. If we believe and follow Jesus and love one another, we too will experience the joy of heaven.

Let us ask Our Blessed Mother to intercede for us and always be with us as we seek to be with her in God's Heavenly Kingdom.
