DEALON'S LORNER Mother Cabrini Feast Day

The memorial for St. Frances Xavier Cabrini. known as Mother Cabrini, will be celebrated on Saturday, November 13. She was an Italian-American sister, who found the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart, to care for the poor children in schools and hospitals in Italy. Pope Leo XIII asked Mother Cabrini to go to the United States to serve the needs of Italian immigrants. In 1889, she arrived in New York City with six sisters to begin their ministry. At first, they established an orphanage in West Park, New York. Trusting in the Lord, during the next 35 years, Mother Cabrini and the sisters created 67 institutions throughout the U.S., which included orphanages, schools, and hospitals to care for the poor, immigrants, and the sick. In this time period, her order had grown to over one thousand sisters. In 1909, Mother Cabrini became a naturalized citizen of the United States. She is the first U.S. citizen to be canonized a saint.

Mother Cabrini is the patron saint of immigrants and hospital administrators. On her feast day, may we pray, "God our Father, who called Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini from Italy to serve the immigrants of America, by her example, teach us to have concern for the stranger, the sick and all those in need, by her prayers help us to see Christ in all the men and women we meet. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen". (*Roman Missal*)


