DEACON

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

This Sunday, June 4, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. In the fourteenth century, Pope John XXII instituted this feast day for the entire church. The celebration became a solemnity after the reforms of Vatican II. The Holy Trinity is "the central mystery of Christian faith and life and is the source of all the other mysteries of faith" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC)*, 234). The Holy Church's life flows from the central belief that the one true God exists as three divine Persons: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In love, God the Father sent His Son "into the world not to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. (John 3:17). Our Savior, Jesus Christ, the Son of God, became man and died for us that we might be saved. After Jesus' Ascension, "the Holy Spirit will be with us forever . . . The Spirit will teach us everything, remind us of all that Christ said to us and bear witness to Him. The Holy Spirit will lead us into all truth and will glorify Christ." (*CCC*, 729).

On this solemnity, may we pray, "O Most Holy Trinity, Almighty God, we adore You, who gives life and vigor to every creature and who shed light eternal where there is darkness. We offer you our hearts, our souls, and our whole being, that we may offer praise and love to your glorious Name. Amen."


