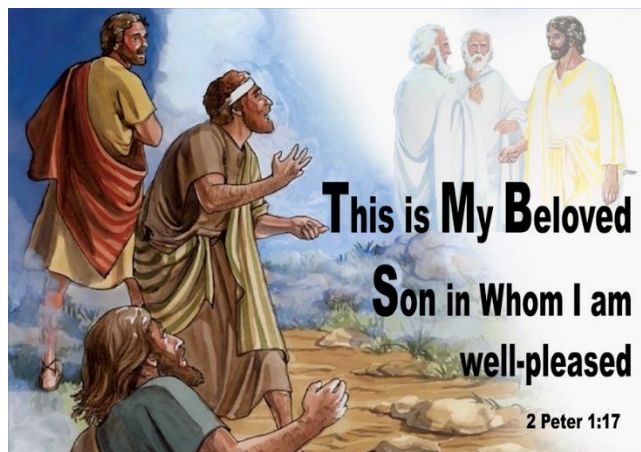

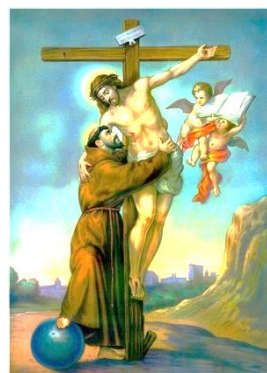

Second Sunday of Lent

First Reading: Genesis 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18

God ordered Abraham to take his beloved only son to Moriah and offer him as a sacrifice. Abraham built an altar and took out a knife to sacrifice his son Isaac. But God called out to him and told him of blessings that would be bestowed on him and his descendants because he had been willing to do what God had asked.

Second Reading: Romans 8:31b-34

Paul reminds the people that God did not spare his only Son, but gave him up for the sake of all people. This proves God views us all as his children, and that no person can harm or condemn us because God will protect us.

Gospel: Mark 9:2-10

Jesus led Peter, James and John up a high mountain, where he conversed with Elijah and Moses. A voice proclaimed 'This is my Son, my beloved. Listen to him.' Then Jesus was alone and warned them not to tell anyone what they had seen until he had risen from the dead.

Deacon's Corner

On the Second Sunday of Lent, the Gospel of St. Mark describes the Transfiguration of Jesus. High on a mountain, Christ was transfigured and "His clothes became dazzling white." Then, a cloud come over Peter, James, and John who accompanied Jesus and a voice proclaims, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him" (Mark 9: 2-10). In this proclamation, God the Father reveals to the three Apostles and us that Jesus is His beloved Son. As the Apostles descend the mountain with Jesus, they are amazed and full of joy.

This Transfiguration shows us who Jesus really is – the Son of God and Our Savior who comes into our world to bring us hope and to save us from sin and death. Like these Apostles, let us make time during this second week of Lent to listen to God's beloved Son in prayer and in charitable actions with our sisters and brothers. In these times, may ask Him, How are you asking me to change? What are you asking me to do?

As we seek answers to these questions, there are many ways that we can quietly listen to Jesus and ask for His grace and help. Make time to read a passage from this week's Gospels and prayerfully meditate on God's Word. Perform a charitable act of mercy or kindness in God's holy name. Say a prayer for those who are poor, suffering, or most in need of God's mercy. Ask the Holy Spirit for an increase in understanding and wisdom to follow Jesus in daily life.
